**OBJECTIVE AND VISION OF THE BRASS GRANT PROGRAM (BRASS
GP)**

The strategic objective of **BRASS GP** is as follows:

- a) To strengthen the performance and quality of scientific work in the field of basic research at FIM in the long term, in accordance with the evaluation of research organizations and the assessment of targeted support programs for research, development, and innovation based on Methodology M17+ of the Government Council for Research, Development, and Innovation.
- b) To enhance the prestige of research teams operating at FIM.
- c) To support projects that, according to expert evaluations, had sufficient scientific research potential but were ultimately not funded.
- d) To support the creation of excellent, internationally competitive research outputs.
- e) To increase the success rate of FIM teams in grant competitions for basic research funded by the national Czech Science Foundation (GACR - Standard Projects, JUNIOR STAR, POSTDOC INDIVIDUAL FELLOWSHIP, POSTDOC INDIVIDUAL FELLOWSHIP OUTGOING, International Projects) and international funding providers, such as European Cooperation in Science and Technology (COST) and the European Research Council (ERC), as well as other scientific research projects.

The vision is to provide targeted support for talented and motivated researchers and their teams, who will work on specific, well-defined, and original projects with the potential to influence their field and gain significant recognition at both national and international levels. Additionally, the program aims to stimulate collaboration among departments and identify and nurture scientific talent.
