Dear Pavel Benak,

I thank you for your mail. Indeed, I was going to contact you myself. We have sent your article to the members of our editorial board already several times, but until now, only one reviewer has signed up for an evaluation.

You can now either decide to withdraw the paper and submit it to another journal of your choice - in which case we will of course send you the one review when we receive it, or you can send us the names, URLs to their homepages and email addresses of 5-6 internationally renown researchers working in the area of the paper and we will contact them with a request for a review. In our experience, this is usually successful so that the paper can be reviewed.

The problem is that a more or less same size body of researchers have to review an immensely growing number of submissions so that the capacity of many reviewers is simply exhausted.

Please let me know your decision.
