Early medieval Towns in Northern Italy

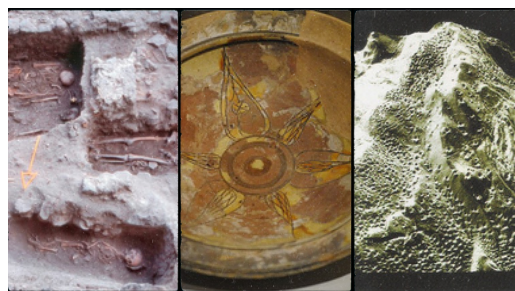

The following topics will be addressed: The crisis and the transformation of the late Antique Towns and the Christianization of the Society; the Renewal of the Carolingian Age (Architecture- Churches, Palatial and Residential buildings-, Urbanistic Aspects).

Medieval Archaeology in Italy

The course deals with the methodological approaches and the main themes of the Medieval Archaeology in Italy. After a short introduction to the history of the discipline the main themes are: Towns, Countryside, Castles and fortified sites, Necropolis and Churches, Archaeology of production and craft centers, Material Culture (pottery, glass, metallic small finds)



Elisa Possenti



Elisa Possenti studied in Venice (MA) and Bologna (PhD). Since 2006 she is Professor of Christian and Medieval Archeology at the University of Trento.

Her main scientific interests concern the archaeological evidences of "barbarians people" in Italy during the late Antiquity and Middle Ages, until the 10/11th C. a.D. Other studies have focalized funerary archaeology in Middle Ages; production, chronology and trade of early medieval metallic items; the alpine areas with particular regard to late antique/medieval castles and churches.
