Call for Applications for Non-European Study Mobility Academic Year 2026/2027

The Philosophical Faculty of the University of Hradec Králové hereby announces a call for applications for **non-European study mobility programmes** carried out the basis of bilateral agreements for the academic year **2026/2027**. The call is open to students of FF UHK (full-time and combined forms of study, all levels of study). **The study stay is scheduled** to take place during the **winter or summer semester** of the academic year **2026/2027**. Application deadline: 25 February 2026

Mandatory attachments:

- **Letter of Motivation** written in the teaching language of the host university (Latin America – Spanish; Brazil and Cape Verde – Portuguese; all other destinations – English). Format: PDF; file name: *MD_name_surname*; maximum length: one A4 page.
- **Structured Curriculum Vitae** written in the teaching language of the host university. Format: PDF; file name: *CV_name_surname*; maximum length: two A4 pages.
- **Transcript of Records from the STAG systém**, format: PDF; file name: *STAG_name_surname*. Applicants commencing the first year of NMgr. or Ph.D. studies are required to submit a transcript of records from their previous studies.

Selection criteria: language proficiency in the host institution's teaching language, motivation to study abroad, and, for Bachelor's students, prior international experience.

Selection procedure: The selection will take the form of an online interview, held within approximately fourteen days of the application deadline. Applicants will receive an official invitation with the date and time.

Recommendation: Applicants should verify programme and course availability on the host institution's website, noting that the academic calendar and semester structure may differ from UHK's.

Mobility implementation is subject to the security and epidemiological situation in the host country. The Faculty of Arts of UHK reserves the right to postpone, modify, or cancel the stay.
