

During my Erasmus+ stay in Hradec Králové, I had a very positive academic and personal experience. One of the things I appreciated the most was the structure of the lectures and seminars. The study groups were relatively small, which created a more comfortable atmosphere for discussion. Because of this, it was much easier to actively participate, ask questions, and exchange opinions with lecturers and other students. I felt that the teaching was more interactive than what I was used to before.

The courses also suited my study plan very well. I was able to choose subjects that matched my academic interests, and the lectures often included interesting detailed information instead of only general introductions to the topics. This made the studies more engaging and useful for my future education.

I also enjoyed living in Hradec Králové itself. The city is calm, clean, and very walkable, which made everyday life comfortable and stress-free. The exam session started at the beginning of May, which meant that I finished my semester studies earlier than I usually do at my home university. Earlier information about the exam schedule would have helped me organize my studies and travel plans more comfortably.

Overall, my Erasmus+ experience in Hradec Králové was valuable both academically and personally. I improved my communication skills, experienced a different study environment, and gained many useful experiences that I will remember positively in the future.
