- Letter of Motivation extent max. 1 A4, addressed to the head of the selection committee doc.

- 2. **CV** in a language of teaching at the given university, extent max. 2 A4, pdf format, name of the file CV_name_surname
- Transcript of Records downloaded from STAG system, pdf format, name of the file STAG_name_surname

Selection procedure: every applicant will receive and e-mail with exact date and time of an interview.

Student selection criteria: language skills, quality of the Letter of Motivation, current study results, link of the Mobility for Studies with applicant's specialization in his/her field of study, quality of applicant's oral presentation.

The realization of the Mobility for Studies will depend on current epidemiological conditions of the foreign university's country and UHK reserves the right to postpone or cancel the given mobility.
