First of all, I would like to introduce myself. I am Welele Weldie Welderufael, an exchange student at the University of Hradec Králové, Philosophical Faculty (Czech Republic) from Addis Ababa University, Ethiopia. I study political science.

I got the opportunity to apply for Erasmus+ program because my home university is its partner. My home university nominated me after evaluating my motivation letter, grade, and interview that considers the language skill. Thanks to the close follow-up of my coordinator, both at my home university and at the UHK, I successfully collected the necessary documents, got a visa to travel to the Czech Republic, and was able to realize my mobility. Erasmus' joy and curiosity to experience new challenges came to me when I was first recruited and allowed to participate. Since I have never been to a foreign country before, this program is very important for me; I have gained a lot of experience, and I have been able to get out of my comfort zone and face and adopt new challenges.
