Choose one book of academic or scientific literature you have read recently and briefly present its outline. · a copy of passport * the authenticity of these documents have to be verified by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in the foreign country and by the Czech embassy (or obtained with apostille). The documents are object to comparison to the Czech educational system
