



## Dean's Prize Competition for employees and students of the FoS UHK

### Article 1

- (1) To increase the quality of scientific work at FoS UHK, the Dean of FoS UHK announces for the employees and students of FoS UHK the annual so-called "Dean's Prize Competition" (hereinafter referred to only as the "Competition"), awarded in the following four areas:
  - a) scientific publication in a journal with IF,
  - b) a foreign monograph published in a reputable publishing house (the list of such publishing houses is to be found in Attachment 2 of this Decision),
  - c) Patents and Applied Results categories,
  - d) a national or international scientific grant.

*A scientific result*, as understood in the following text, is a result from one of the previously stated areas a), b), or c).
- (2) Each employee and student of FoS UHK can apply for the competition by physical submission of the application form (see Attachment No. 1) to the Science and Research Officer **by 31/12** of the given calendar year. In the case of missing documents, the committee can ask for other documents to be submitted.
- (3) Sign up for the Competition is subject to an application which specifies the proposed prize distribution among all co-authors from the employees and students of FoS UHK; all co-authors from FoS UHK in such application agree with the proposed division by their signature. The application for the Competition can be submitted only by the alphabetically first author of the submitted scientific result from all FoS UHK co-authors or a recipient (co-recipient) of the scientific grant obtained at FoS UHK.
- (4) In the given calendar year, only a grant whose recipient or co-recipient has been contractually bound by UHK and the stated grant agency in the previous year can apply for the Competition.
- (5) In the areas a), b), c) only scientific results that have not been submitted to the Competition in previous years can be entered into the Competition.
- (6) Each employee and student can apply any number of their grants or scientific results for the Competition in each of the areas referred to in paragraph (1).

- (7) The final ranking of the competitors will be set up by a committee consisting of the Dean, Vice-Deans and Heads of Departments, chaired by the Dean of FoS. The order shall be drawn up separately for each area referred to in paragraph (1).
- (8) The final ranking is officially announced by the Dean of FoS UHK no later than one month after the end date of the Competition; the financial prizes will be paid to the competitors on the following payout date.

8 <sup>th</sup> – 10 <sup>th</sup>	CZK 1,000.00

This Decision shall enter into force on the day of its signature.  
The Dean's Decision No. 2/2017 is hereby repealed.
