

## Student Mobility Scholarships

### Student mobility scholarships

The Dean's decision deals with the financing of mobility of students enrolled in the current academic year to study at Faculty of Science (FoS) UHK for study and internship at foreign universities or institutions. It also covers the financing of the mobility of foreign students at FoS UHK. The mobility period shall be at least 31 days. Incoming students shall be assigned to a study program at FoS UHK in STAG during their stay.

- I. A student enrolled in full-time studies at FoS UHK can apply for an extraordinary residence scholarship for foreign mobility within the subsidized programs (e.g. ERASMUS+, EDUCA, AIA) according to the following table and after submission of all necessary documents:

- II. A student of FoS UHK can apply for an extraordinary residence scholarship (not applicable for subsidized mobility) for a mobility to foreign country outside the EU for a period of stay longer than 31 days. For each completed 31 days of international mobility, the student can apply for a maximum of 20,000.00 CZK.

The student can also apply for reimbursement of travel expenses from the permanent residence to the place of foreign mobility and back. The amount of compensation is shown in the table – **Travel expenses**.

- III. A foreign student enrolled at FoS UHK, except for subsidized programs (ERASMUS+, EDUCA, AIA, summer schools and others), can apply for an extraordinary scholarship of max. 10,000.00 CZK for each completed 31 days of stay.

The student can also ask for reimbursement of travel expenses from the permanent residence to Hradec Kralove and back<sup>1</sup>. The amount of compensation is shown in the table
