

Funding for the Publication of Articles in Top Quality Open Access Journals from WOS according to AIS in 2022

Intent of the programme:

The intent of this programme is to support financially the possibility of publishing in excellent Open Access journals that are included in the Web of Science database and belong to the focus of research conducted at the PřF UHK.

Programme objective:

The main objective of this programme is to support further improvement of quality of publication results reported by the PřF UHK according to the current requirements of the H17+ methodology.

Maximum amount requested per article:

The applicant may request reimbursement of the publication fee (APC) for publishing an article in an Open Access journal up to a maximum of CZK 100,000.

Method of funding decision:

The application is submitted to the Vice-Dean for Creative Activities, who prepares a financial analysis of the suitability of APC funding from this programme (the decisive factor is the position of the article according to AIS in the given WoS category and the PřF UHK author's share in the article). The financial analysis is submitted to the Dean for his decision on funding.

Requirements for articles submitted to this program:

- The article must be accepted in a *journal* that meets the following requirements:
 - It is included in at least one category in the Journal Category Ranking

- (JCR) on Web of Science (WoS);
- It has a calculated Article Influence Score (AIS) on WoS;
 - In at least one of the JCR WoS categories in which it is included on WoS, it is in Q1 according to AIS (i.e. in the top 25% of journals).
 - At least one of the authors of the article is an employee or student of the PřF UHK, who has the address of the PřF UHK listed as **his only address** in the article (i.e. he/she has "**Faculty of Science, University of Hradec Králové**" as part of his affiliation in the article).
 - The applicant must include with their application the original invoice issued by the journal for payment of the APC for Open Access.
