

Evaluation of the 2022 PřF UHK Dean's Prize Competition

A total of 37 applications were submitted for the 2022 PřF UHK Dean's Prize Competition by 31 December 2021, of which:

- 28 in category a) Scientific Publication in a Journal with IF;
- 0 in category b) Foreign Monograph Published by a Reputable Publishing House;
