

The priest who plays offense: Prof. Tomáš Petráček merges tradition with a vision for a better tomorrow

Professor Tomáš Petráček, a Catholic theologian, historian, and academic from the Faculty of Education UHK (Pedagogická fakulta UHK, PdF UHK), critically reflects on the intersections of religion, modernity, and education. He advocates for the involvement of young people in shaping a more inclusive and humane society. In our interview, he spoke about science, social change, Education — and football.





Secularization and modernity have

deeply influenced our societies. Even in similar cultures like Poland and the Czech Republic, religious identity shaped national consciousness in distinct ways. Understanding how religion, culture, and history intersect — and how to communicate about them — is essential. Misconceptions are common: for example. contrary to popular belief, not every Muslim is a supporter of Wahhabism or religious fundamentalism.

SUSTAINABLE UHK

The Faculty of Science UHK joins international pollinator conservation projects

At the Faculty of Science UHK (Přírodovědecká fakulta UHK, PřF UHK), specialists lead training programs focused on the conservation of bees and other pollinators. These sessions, open to both experts and enthusiasts from across Europe, deepen understanding of these vital species and address the alarming decline in their populations. Wild solitary bees and butterflies are particularly emphasized due to their critical ecological roles and vulnerability.

Pollinator protection is increasingly reflected in EU directives and agricultural policy—highlighting its importance for biodiversity and food security.
