Temporary Change in the Manner of Submission of Advanced Master's and Doctoral Theses

Article 1

- 1. In connection with the restrictions and precautions taken in relation to the COVID-19 pandemics, the provisions of Art. 5, Para. 2 of Rector's Decree No. 13/2017 "Rules for Bachelor's, Master's, Advanced Master's, Doctoral and Habilitation Theses Handling at the UHK" (the "Rules") are being amended for the period set in Article 2 as follows: *"Students submit their Advanced Master's or doctoral theses in the number of one digital copy in an electronic form. After the thesis has been defended, the electronic version of the thesis is retained by the UHK."*
- 2. The first sentence of Art. 5, Para. 3, Art. 9 and Art. 11, Para. 1 of the Rules will not apply during the period set in Article 2 hereof for the purposes of final theses per Para. 1 of this Article.

Article 2

The provisions of Article 1 apply to the advanced master's and doctoral theses submitted after the day this Decree comes to effect.

Article 3

This Decree comes to force and effect on the day of being signed.
