
BLACKBOARD

Blackboard is a platform for e-learning study. Blackboard contains courses and materials for students and makes basic support for every subject.


You will find portal on web address https://oliva.uhk.cz

Step by step:

- 1. Start web browser you have with HTML support (Microsoft Edge, Chrome, Firefox, Opera, Safari). All todays web browsers have this support instead of Internet Explorer
- 2. Type https://oliva.uhk.cz and press Enter



3. Wait for welcome screen of Blackboard portal




4. Before login, you must change language of web application with small icon on the left upper corner to English.




5. Put your credentials into login field on the page:



6. You will see dashboard of Blackboard with list of courses you are member and your announcements.




All pages in Blackboard contains announcement bar in upper right corner. This bar has

information about courses and settings of my account.




WORKS WITH COURSES


You can find all available courses in module **My Courses**. Just click on course you want to enter. Every student has access to different courses. For example: **Ontologies and Semantic Web**




Left side contains menu with course categories and available tools. Every course has different menu.




You can hide this menu with arrow on the right side of menu. If you want to bring menu back, you will click on the same arrow.
