

## Warning for students accommodated at the UHK Dormitory

Based on the Emergency by the Government of the Czech Republic  
that includes above others:

- prohibition of a free movement of all the citizens in the Czech Republic,
- regulation of free movement in public of the citizens staying in the Czech Republic, their presence in the public shall be limited to minimum, they should stay in their place of living,
- regulation of contact with other people limited only to the essential extent

and

- prohibition of people going outside of their accommodation without respiratory protection (that means covering mouth and nose),

it is prohibited in the premises of the UHK Dormitory and around for accommodated students:

- to freely move, except of arranging essential living needs or studies,
- to gather in the common areas, rooms, flats, outside areas,
- to go to the common areas of the UHK Dormitory without a respiratory protection covering nose and mouth (it includes halls, elevators, laundry, reception etc.).

Violation of the regulations stated above might lead to a decision by the Director of the Dormitory. This decision would cancel accommodation immediately according to the paragraph 1 letter e) of the Accommodation Contract based on the Article 6 Termination of the Accommodation, paragraph 2, letter c) of the Dormitory Rules at the UHK Dormitory.

**We ask all the students to keep to the Dormitory Rules at the UHK Dormitory.**
